If you are able to get to a hospital emergency department, there is one located at the **University of Minnesota Hospital** at 2450 Riverside Avenue (on the corner of 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Street) at the West Bank Campus (3 minutes by car from the Radisson Hotel on Washington Avenue).

Alternatively, there is an emergency department at **Hennepin County Medical Center** on the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> Street South and Park Avenue South in Minneapolis (5 minutes by car from the Radisson Hotel on Washington Avenue).

We also have a medical practitioner with the University of Minnesota Physicians who is willing to see attendees with non-emergency medical conditions.
